1. Responses:

a. We are at 178 calls for the year.

2. Operations:

- a. <u>Personnel</u>: We have started 24 hr. shifts and it has made a massive improvement in emergency response. We have received positive feedback from our partner agencies on providing 24/7 coverage.
- b. <u>Projects:</u> All summer projects are completed except Ladder testing which will take place on Nov 30.
- c. <u>Isolation Protocols:</u> We are under the Kootenai County Isolation and PPE protocols. Our numbers in Kootenai County continue to rise and I am expecting the restrictions to continue through the winter.
- d. Resident: We are interviewing a potential resident on 11/21/20.

3. Training:

- i. All group training has been cancelled until further notice due to isolation protocols.
- ii. I have purchased Rescue 1 Learning Management System and am in the process of setting up the program so we can deliver distance learning to our members.

4. Projects:

a. Residence:

- i. Sewer, power, water, and heat are all in and working.
- ii. Gutters have been quoted and will be installed once a decision has been made on heat trace.
- iii. Decks are completed and Tom is contacting the county for a conditional occupancy certificate so our firefighters can occupy.
- iv. Parking and landscaping are the last things that need to be completed.
